

Notas de Antropología de las Américas Call for Papers

The Department of Anthropology of the Americas at the University of Bonn invites the academic community to submit articles for the first issue of **Notas de Antropología de las Américas (NAA**, Notes on Anthropology of the Americas), an international journal that aims to promote multidisciplinary work in the social sciences with a focus on Latin America. Unpublished proposals on anthropological, archaeological, historical, linguistic, ethnohistorical and related disciplines research will be received. We also welcome students' work from seminars, internships, fieldwork or final B.A., M.A. and/or PhD dissertations, which provide original contributions to their discipline.

The NAA journal is planned as an open-access electronic periodical publication, which will have its own ISSN for proper identification.

All manuscripts submitted to NAA will be evaluated and subjected to peer review. We accept the following types of contributions:

Articles

- Regular or themed Articles, with a maximum length of 50,000 characters.
- Bibliographic Balances with analysis and central argument on the subject treated in the volume with a maximum length of 50,000 characters.

Reports

- Book reviews (not older than 3 years at the date of application to the journal), with a maximum length of 7,000 characters.
- Self-authored interviews with a maximum length of 25,000 characters.
 Sources
- Transcripts of historical sources and/or documents, which must include a critical analysis or commentary, with a maximum length of 25,000 characters.

Characters include spaces. Submissions can be sent in German, Spanish, Portuguese or English.
